The 50th Super Bowl

Did you realize this is the 50th Super Bowl? Most can't remember the first one. Just for your information and to save you Googling it while I talk, the Green Bay Packers beat the Kansas City Chiefs in the first Super Bowl. Unless you are a fan of either of those teams or you are a trivia nut you probably did not know that. Who could name all 49 previous winners?

A lot has changed since that first Super Bowl in 1967. Consider that...

Then the cheapest ticket cost \$6 and now the cheapest ticket will run over \$3K.

Those commercials we love to watch? A 30 second commercial for this year's game will cost \$5 million for an average of \$167K per second! In Super Bowl I commercials sold for \$42,000!

So a lot has changed since that first Super Bowl. Another thing that has changed is that Americans use to give more to their church than they do now. In 1967 Americans gave over 3% of their disposable incomes to their church. Today that percentage is about 2%! The irony is that contrary to what we think we make more money today than we did in 1967. Personal income for Americans increased 137% while giving decreased 28%! So we make more but give less!
