## The Principle of First

If somehow you missed it today is Mother's Day. So call if your mom is still living make sure you call her today!

Proverbs 31 ends with a tribute to a wife and mother of noble character. It contains 22 verses talking about her attributes. What does your bank account and calendar show that you love first? What you focus on first will determine your direction in life.

Our moms put us first before themselves. Today you benefit from that love. This morning as we take up our offering it is a time that we can show God that He is first in our lives. The Bible calls it a First Fruit offering. Giving God the best and first of the harvest was the way God's people showed that God was first. Will you give your best and first of your "harvest" to support God's work?
