

We Give Because He Gave

The most famous verse in the Bible is John 3:16. Let's repeat that verse together. I think this one verse sums up Christmas. God loves us so much that He sent His one and only son, Jesus, to bring us the hope of eternal life. Notice the verse says, "For God, *so loved* the world that He *gave...*" We give gifts this Christmas to those we love but none of us will give a gift as costly as one of our children.
